Helping regional Australia respond to the global financial crisis Geraldton, Busselton and Mandurah public hearings and forums

The House of Representatives Regional Development Committee is conducting a series of public hearings as part of its inquiry into the impact of the global financial crisis on regional Australia.

The Committee will be holding hearings in Geraldton, Busselton and Mandurah, Western Australia on the 29th and 30th of April and the 1st of May. - Busselton, Thursday, 30 April 2009, Shire of Busselton Council Chamber Room, 2 Southern Drive; and
- Mandurah, Friday, 1 May 2009. Mandurah City Council Tuckey Room, 3 Peel Street

The **Geraldton** public hearing will be held between **11 am and 2.00 pm** with the public forum to follow.

The **Busselton** public hearing will be held between **9 am and 2.00 pm** with the public forum to follow.

The **Mandurah** public hearing will be held between **9 am and 1.30 pm** with the public forum to follow.
