Professor Larissa Behrendt – an academic, writer and aboriginal affairs advocate - is a Eualeyai/Kamillaroi woman.

She serves as the Professor of Law and Director of Research at the Jumbunna Indigenous House of Learning at the University of Technology, Sydney.

She is a Judicial Member of the Administrative Decisions Tribunal, Equal Opportunity Division and is the Alternative Chair of the Serious Offenders Review Board.

Larissa has published on property law, indigenous rights, dispute resolution and Aboriginal women's issues. Her book, *Achieving Social Justice: Indigenous Rights and Australia's Future* was published by The Federation Press in 2003. She won the 2002 David Uniapon Award and a 2005 Commonwealth Writer's Prize for her novel *Home*.

She is a Board Member of the Museum of Contemporary Art, a Director of the Sydney Writers festival and a Director of the famed Bangarra Dance Theatre.
