

The Wentworth Group to appear at inquiry into future water supplies for Australia's rural industries and communities

Public hearing in Canberra, Wednesday 8 October, 2003

The House of Representatives Agriculture Committee is examining the role of the Commonwealth in ensuring adequate and sustainable future water supplies for communities and industries in rural and regional Australia.

This Wednesday (8 October) the committee will conduct a public hearing with three representatives of The Wentworth Group: Mr Peter Cosier, Environmental Policy Specialist, WWF Australia; Prof Peter Cullen, Freshwater Ecologist and Australian Environmentalist of the Year 2001; and Dr John Williams Agricultural Scientist and Chief Land and Water, CSIRO.

The scientists who formed The Wentworth Group believe drought-proofing Australia is not feasible. They say that Australians must learn to live within the limitations of their environment and to adjust land-use practices and expectations accordingly. On 31 July 2003 The Wentworth Group published a '*Blueprint for a National Water Plan*' which advocates a number of water reforms to reverse the degradation of Australia's landscapes.

The public hearing will provide an opportunity for the Committee to learn more about the proposals advocated by The Wentworth Group.

The Committee Chair, Mrs Kay Elson MP, says the inquiry has generated considerable interest around Australia, with more than 165 submissions received from concerned organisations and individuals.

"Getting water management right, which includes the balance of allocations between different users, is crucial not only for the prosperity of rural Australia, but the nation as a whole," Mrs Elson said.
