## RE: CONSTRUCTION OF NEW WAREHOUSING FACILITIES AT WADSWORTH BARRACKS – EAST BANDIANA, VIC

Dear Mr Catchpole

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Statement of Evidence for the above mentioned works for the Department of Defence.

A review of the Statement of Evidence to the Joint Parliamentary Standing Committee on Public Works has been carried out for compliance with the *Energy in Government* Operations (EEGO) policy.

The statement describes features aimed at ensuring energy efficiency however, more broadly, the following should be also considered:

- At Para. 40 (b) (ii), ideally metering on energy usage should be structured to ensure separation between area of different purpose where costeffective and practical. In particular, separation of metering between office areas and warehouse and tenant light and power energy supply should be separately metered from heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) and cooling tower supply.
- At Para. 40 (b) (viii), controls on energy use zones should be limited to 100m<sup>2</sup> of office space per zone.
