The Standing Orders Committee has considered the matter of incorporating in the Standing Orders of the House a suitable provision to meet the requirements occasioned by the proposed Opening of the Parliament by Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second on Her impending visit to Australia, and recommends to the House that the fellowing new Standing Order be adopted and inserted in Chapter II:-

"lA. On any occasion upon which Her Majesty the Queen intends to declare in person the causes of the calling together of the Parliament, the House shall attend Her Majesty at the time and place appointed".
