#### DUTIES OF THE COMMITTEE

Section 8 of the Public Accounts Committee Act 1951-1966 reads as follows:

- 8. The duties of the Committee are-
  - (a) to examine the accounts of the receipts and expenditure of the Commonwealth and each statement and report transmitted to the Houses of Parliament by the Auditor-General in pursuance of sub-section (1.) of section fifty-three of the Audit Act 1901-1951;
  - (b) to report to both Houses of the Parliament, with such comment as it thinks fit, any items or matters in those accounts, statements and reports, or any circumstances connected with them, to which the Committee is of the opinion that the attention of the Parliament should be directed;
  - (c) to report to both Houses of the Parliament any alteration which the Committee thinks desirable in the form of the public accounts or in the method of keeping them, or in the mode of receipts, control, issue or payment of public moneys; and
  - (d) to inquire into any question in connexion with the public accounts which is referred to it by either House of the Parliament, and to report to that House upon that question,

and include such other duties as are assigned to the Committee by Joint Standing Orders approved by both Houses of the Parliament.

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#### **FOREWORD**

On 8 April 1965, Your Committee presented to the Parliament in the Sixty-ninth Report an Index to the first sixty-eight reports of the Joint Committee of Public Accounts. This revised Index now covers the eighty-nine reports issued by the first six Committees in the period of fourteen years between the appointment of the First Committee on 25 September 1952, and the presentation of the Eighty-ninth Report. the last report of the Sixth Committee on 27 October 1966.

The method of compilation of this Index is similar to that adopted previously. Topics have been listed under main subject headings and then is indicated the number of report and the page, or the first of a succession of pages, in that report where the topic will be found. Commonwealth departments are indexed uniformly under the key name of the department, e.g., 'Trade and Industry Department' and not 'Department of Trade and Industry'. Authorities whose formal titles commence with 'Commonwealth' or 'Australia' are so indexed with a cross reference under a commonly used name, for example, 'Australian Wheat Board' is indexed under 'Australian' with a cross reference under 'Wheat Board', Treasury Minutes, conveying to the Committee the action taken by the Treasury and departments on their reports, are indexed under 'Treasury Minutes'.

The following example will illustrate the way in which the Index is to be interpreted:---

'RECRUITING CAMPAION-

Provision in Army Votes .. 20/12, 20; 25/30, 39; 27/46,

This subject and topic are referred to in the Twentieth Report, pages 12 and 20, in the Twenty-fifth Report, pages 30 and 39, and in the Twenty-seventh Report, page 46.

The Committee will continue to add to the Index from time to time.
