INTERIM REPORT

The House of Representatives has referred the following projects to the Public Works Committee for investigation and report:

- Construction of National Medical Cyclotron Facility, Royal Prince Alfred Hospital, Sydney (limit of cost \$8.9m at January 1988 prices)
- Construction of New Communications and Recruit Schools, HMAS Cerberus, Crib Point, Vic (limit of cost \$15.95m at April 1988 prices)
- Construction of National Biological Standards Laboratory, Symonston, ACT (limit of cost \$51.4m at July 1988 prices)

The Committee has concluded its considerations of each of these references but will be unable to table reports until early in the 1989 autumn sittings. However, in view of the delay before reports can be tabled, the Committee wishes to inform the Parliament that it will be recommending the construction of each of the works proposed in these references.
