Inquiry into regional aviation in Australia

Public hearings in Wagga Wagga and Sydney, Wednesday 7 May – Thursday 8 May 2003

The House of Representatives Transport and Regional Services Committee is examining the adequacy of regional aviation services and transport links to Australia's major populated islands.

The Committee will visit **Wagga Wagga** and **Sydney** next week to gather evidence from government, airline operators and airport owners.

House Transport Committee Chair, Mr Paul Neville MP, said the inquiry has generated considerable interest around Australia with 171 submissions received from interested organisations and individuals.

Regional aviation services are adjusting to the significant recent shocks such as fuel contamination, Ansett's collapse, terrorism and insurance. The committee will be taking evidence from some carriers offering regional services," he said.

"While larger centres are well served by the current aviation arrangements, services could be improved to a number of regional centres, particularly those in remote Australia. Key issues are costs and returns, service levels, interconnectivity between services, regulation and coordination," Mr Neville said.

He said, "Another emerging issue is the maintenance of country airports."
